ORIGINS OF THE NAME

- The “origins in Poland” theory
 - I was interested to find that Val had also heard this one
 - Michalski is a Polish surname (meaning Polish and Jewish according to Ancestry)
 - DNA tests for various family members contradict this
- Mitche – meaning “bread” in old English
 - No identified connection as far as I am aware.
- Mitchen Hall
 - Surname first recorded in Surrey in 14th Century
 - Mitchen Hall recorded in 1419
 - Concentration of the surname around Shackleford and Elstead in the 15th and 16th Century

WEST SURREY TO WEST KENT?

- Is there any evidence to link the Mitchenall's in Shackleford (14th to 18th Century) with those in Edenbridge?
- Links in Edenbridge go back to Henry Mitchenall, 1650 to 1712.
- Bletchingly Parish records in 14th Century (1347)
 - “Henry de Michenhale is new and has remained in Michenall's (or Mitchenor's) Farm; Mitchenall being a place name in Godalming parish, whence perhaps Henry came.”
- So there were Mitchenall's in East Surrey recorded before Henry in 1650.
- No precise evidence yet

EARLIER MITCHENALLS – THE LINE BEFORE WILLIAM

ARE THERE DESCENDANTS NOT FROM WILLIAM?

- Henry (1650 -1712)
 - had 6 Children in Edenbridge, Elizabeth, George, Henry John, Andrew and William. Henry had a daughter Sarah, who died when Henry was 49
- William 1691-1769)
 - Had two children, son William (1730 – 1786) and daughter Rebecca (who died aged 9)
- William (1730 – 1786)
 - had 5 children, Rebecca, John, Ann, William and George
 - George died in infancy, William at sea. Only John had children named Mitchenall
- John (1759 – 1820)
 - had 7 children, Nancy, John, George, Elizabeth, Sarah, William and James.
 - Nancy, Elizabeth and George all died before adulthood.
 - John and William are reported to have children
- John (1783 – 1869)
 - Married twice (Mary, first wife, died)
 - had 5 daughters and 2 sons. In 1885 the last Mitchenall descendant in this tree died (son John).

WILLIAM AND MARY (MITCHENALL) MARRIED 1821

- William, son of John Mitchenall (1759 – 1820) , was born in 1793.
- He married Mary Winter in 1821.
- By 1838 they had 12 children
 - William, Mary, Ann, John, James, Amos, Kezia, George, Joshua, Samuel, Rebecca and William.
- After 1885, the only Mitchenalls traced or recorded are descendants of William and Mary Mitchenall.
- Of their 8 sons who could have had Mitchenall sons, only three have living progeny called Mitchenall
 - The first William died in infancy.
 - John's last descendants named Mitchenall died in 1966.
 - James last descendants named Mitchenall died in 1923
 - Amos and Samuel had no sons
- All living Mitchenalls are descendants of George, Joshua or the younger William

WHY ST GEORGE THE MARTYR?



- St George the Martyr is located in Borough High Street, SE1
- William Mitchenall and Mary Winter married there
- Of the remaining 11 marriages in the immediate Mitchenall family
 - 9 were at St George the Martyr.
- The church clock at St Peter and St Paul in Edenbridge
 - comes from St George the martyr
- But I have no clear reason why, when they did not live there, the family largely married there.
 - Those who married there often took up temporary residence nearby.

THE DETAIL OF WILLIAM AND MARY MITCHENALL'S CHILDREN

- William (1822 – 1826) Died aged 4, no descendants
- Mary (1823 – 1843) No record of descendants
- John (1825 – 1898), No Mitchenall descendants
- Ann (1825-1896) No record of descendants
- James (1829 – 1881) No Mitchenall descendants
- Amos (1830 – 1867) No living descendants
- Kezia (1831 – 1895) No Mitchenall Descendants
- **George (1832 – 1904) Living Mitchenall descendants**
- **Joshua (1833 – 1908) Living Mitchenall Descendants**
- Simon / Samuel (1835-1903) No record of descendants
- Rebekah or Rebecca (1837 – 1901) No descendants
- **William (1838 – 1905) Living Mitchenall Descendants**

WILLIAM MITCHENALL (1822 – 1826)

- Died in infancy

MARY (1823 – 1843)

- Left home early and died at 20 (not at home on 1841 census)
- No record of marriage or children
- Birth and death recorded in Edenbridge parish registers

JOHN (1825 – 1898)

- Twin to Ann
- Married Anne Bashford from Worth at St James, Clerkenwell
- Had two children, Elizabeth and William (Henry)
- Elizabeth married and her descendants are Leigh
- William Henry married and had four sons.
- None had any children; last Mitchenall's died in 1966 (Edward and Harold)

ANN (1825 – 1896)

- Twin to John
- Married William Henry Austin at St George the Martyr.
- No record of children.
- Lived with and provided shelter for other family members – almost a lodging house!
- At one time had 3 William Mitchenalls living with her at the same time

JAMES (1829 – 1881)

- Married Catherine Harris at St Andrews, Islington
- Had two daughters and a son.
- Son William died in 1923 unmarried
- Daughter Mary died at the age 32 without children
- Daughter Laura married Walter Dugdale
- Descendants named Dugdale, Trickett and Jenkins.

AMOS (1830 - 1867)

- Married Laura Martin at St George the Martyr
- One child recorded – Elizabeth
- No record of Elizabeth marrying found

KEZIA (1831 – 1895)

- Married Henry Jeffrey at St George the Martyr
- They had 6 children
- Descendants how called Jeffrey, Southern, Breadmore, Rogers, Piercy, Goss

GEORGE (1832 -1904)

- George married twice
 - In 1852 he married Elizabeth in St George the Martyr
 - When he married Mary in St George the Martyr in 1861 he was stated to be a widower
- George had 5 Children with his first wife
 - George, Simon, John, Mary and David
- George had 9 children with his second wife
 - Charles, Jane, Sarah, Alfred, Amos, Elizabeth, Agnes, Lily and Margaret

GEORGE'S (1832 -1904) CHILDREN

GEORGE, SIMON, JOHN, MARY AND DAVID CHARLES, JANE, SARAH, ALFRED, AMOS, ELIZABETH, AGNES, LILY AND MARGARET

- Of George's 14 children, Amos and Elizabeth died in the year they were born.
 - George had two boys, and there is a missing Elizabeth Mitchenall (Carter?)
 - Simon had three girls and a boy, but only Florence survived infancy.
 - John was a plumber but never married
 - Mary was running a boarding house in 1911 in Eastbourne
 - Sisters Agnes Lily and Margaret lived there. Sister Sarah (Mrs Dubber) present at census.
 - David married Laura and had 6 children,
 - Violet, Albert, Nellie, David, Dora and Frederick



LOOKING AT SON DAVID IN MORE DETAIL

DAVID GEORGE, SON OF GEORGE

- David married Laura and had 6 Children
 - Violet came back first class from South Africa in 1953, aged 65 and single
 - Albert married Rose Hook in 1911 in Ontario.
 - The living US Mitchenalls are his descendants.
 - Nellie died single at 32
 - David married Lillian Bloy in 1916 in Streatham, and had 3 children Ruby, Sybil and David
 - The Mitchenalls originating from Worcester are all descendants of David (Herbert)
 - Frederick married Beatrice Spreadbury and had 4 children, Frederick, Douglas, Andrew and Marlene
 - The Mitchenalls originating in the Salisbury area are all descendants of Frederick

GEORGE'S (1832 -1904) CHILDREN (CONTINUED)

GEORGE, SIMON, JOHN, MARY AND DAVID CHARLES, JANE, SARAH, ALFRED, AMOS, ELIZABETH, AGNES, LILY AND MARGARET

- We've looked at George, Simon, John, Mary, David, Amos and Elizabeth
- Charles had 8 children.
 - Lena, Frederick, Robert and Margaret died in infancy.
 - Maud, Florence, Edith and Clara all died in Essex single or married
- Jane was still single she died in 1943 in Essex
- Sarah married Mr WC Dubber and had 2 girls and a boy, son died in Eastbourne in 1913
- Alfred attended Salters Hill School and was still at home single at 24. He died at 25
- Agnes, Lily and Margaret all ran the Boarding House in Eastbourne with Mary.
 - When Lily died in 1954, she left remains of the estate to Clara Lavinia Mitchenall, daughter of Charles.

JOSHUA (1833 – 1908)

- Joshua married Elizabeth at St George the Martyr in 1856.
- Joshua and Elizabeth had seven Children
 - Ellen, Clara, Frederick, William, Arthur, Emily and Fanny
 - Ellen married but had no children
 - Clara married Thomas Hall and had 5 children, some descendants in Australia
 - Frederick married Emily and had three daughters, all who ended up in Nova Scotia.
 - William married Annie and had 7 children
 - Herbert, Sidney, Percy, Ernest, Annie, Arthur and Leonard

JOSHUA (1833 – 1908) (CONTINUED)

MORE DETAIL ON WILLIAM

- William married Annie Pope – children Herbert, Sidney, Percy, Ernest, Annie, Arthur and Leonard
 - Herbert Married Annie and had one daughter, Nancy, who married a Mr Myers. No recent trace
 - Sidney was killed in action in 1917
 - Percy married Agnes in 1922.
 - They had two children, Joyce and Victor who are the oldest Mitchenall's here today
 - Joyce married Kenneth Dorbon and they have two children, Lesley and Wendy
 - Victor married Mary Martin (k/a Pat) and Val and Steve are here today.
 - Ernest married Violet and they had two sons, Stanley and Donald.
 - Stanley married but his one son died in infancy
 - Donald has two children who know about this event, Ashlea (Harraway) and Grant (Mitchenall)
 - Annie married Walter Ross-Gower and has living descendants
 - Arthur married Ivy and their daughter Ivy married in 1968 – no current trace
 - Leonard married Eileen – no record of children

SIMON (1835 – 1903)

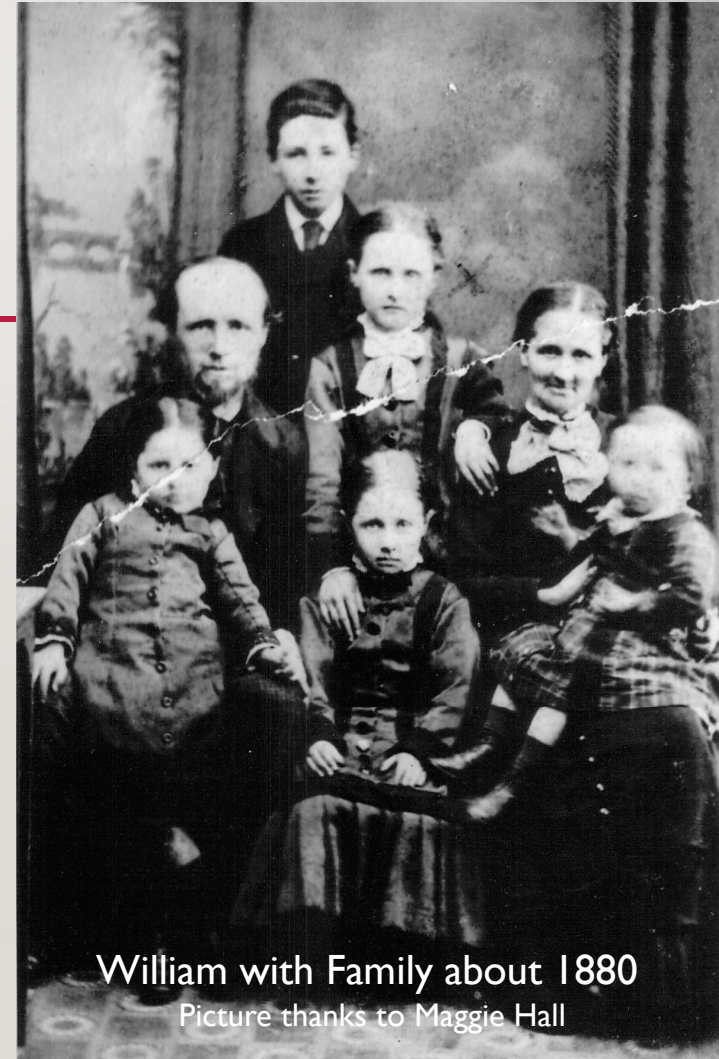
- Married Mary Kirby at St George the Martyr
- He became a Baptist Minister and lived in the Midlands
- Was he sent to Coventry?
- Usually known as Samuel in later life
- No children recorded.

REBEKAH (1837 - 1901)

- Married Robert Kempshall at St George the Martyr
- No record of children.

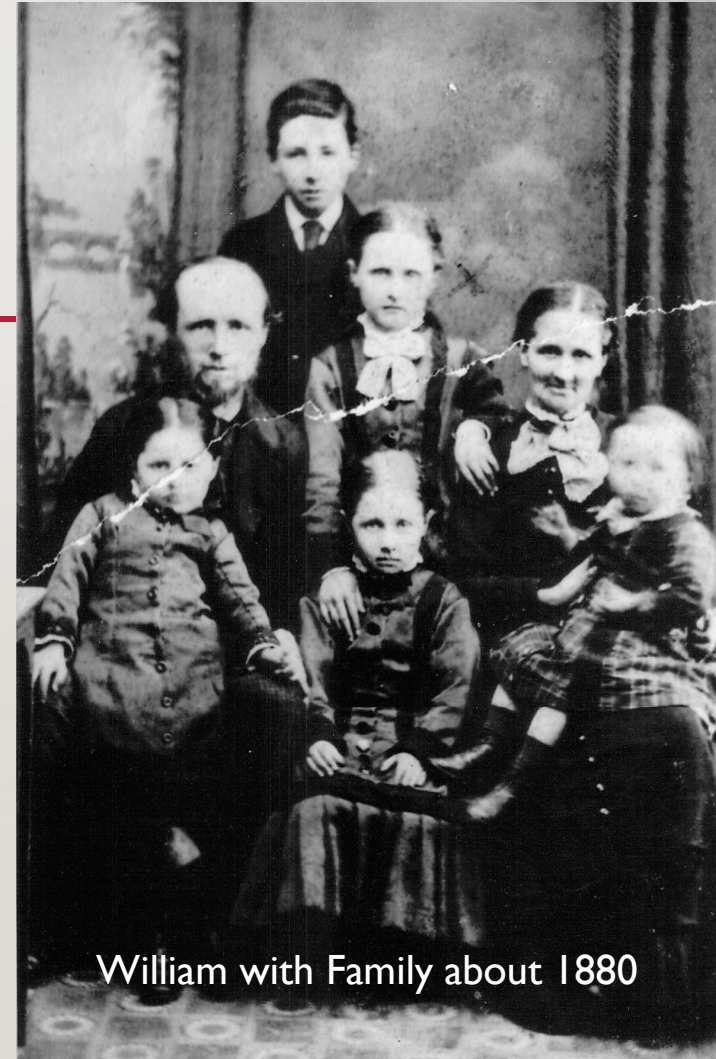
WILLIAM (1838 – 1905)

- William had 6 Children – 5 are depicted in this picture
- My grandfather, Percy, is not in the picture – Egbert is, hence date.
 - Ages of children guessed from photo.
- William Jonathan is 15 and has living descendants (Joan Smethurst)
- Edith is 11 and has many descendants
 - The photo comes from Maggie Hall
 - Edith married Sydney King, and there are now Wallers, Schofields and Chapmans



WILLIAM (1838 – 1905)

- In this photo...continued
- Tamar is 10 and married William Waterhouse.
 - Connections with Australia (Bainbridge) as well as Waterhouses
- Lillian is 5 and married Mario Cesare o Busi
 - Her estate passed to Amy Waller, one of Edith's grandchildren
- Egbert is 2
 - He married Emma. Son Percy died at 3, daughter Bertha in 1967.
- Percy isn't born
 - He married Lillian and had two sons. He died when the eldest was 5.
 - Sons Raymond and Frank were brought up by their mothers family (Crouch).
 - There are several descendant Mitchenall's here.....

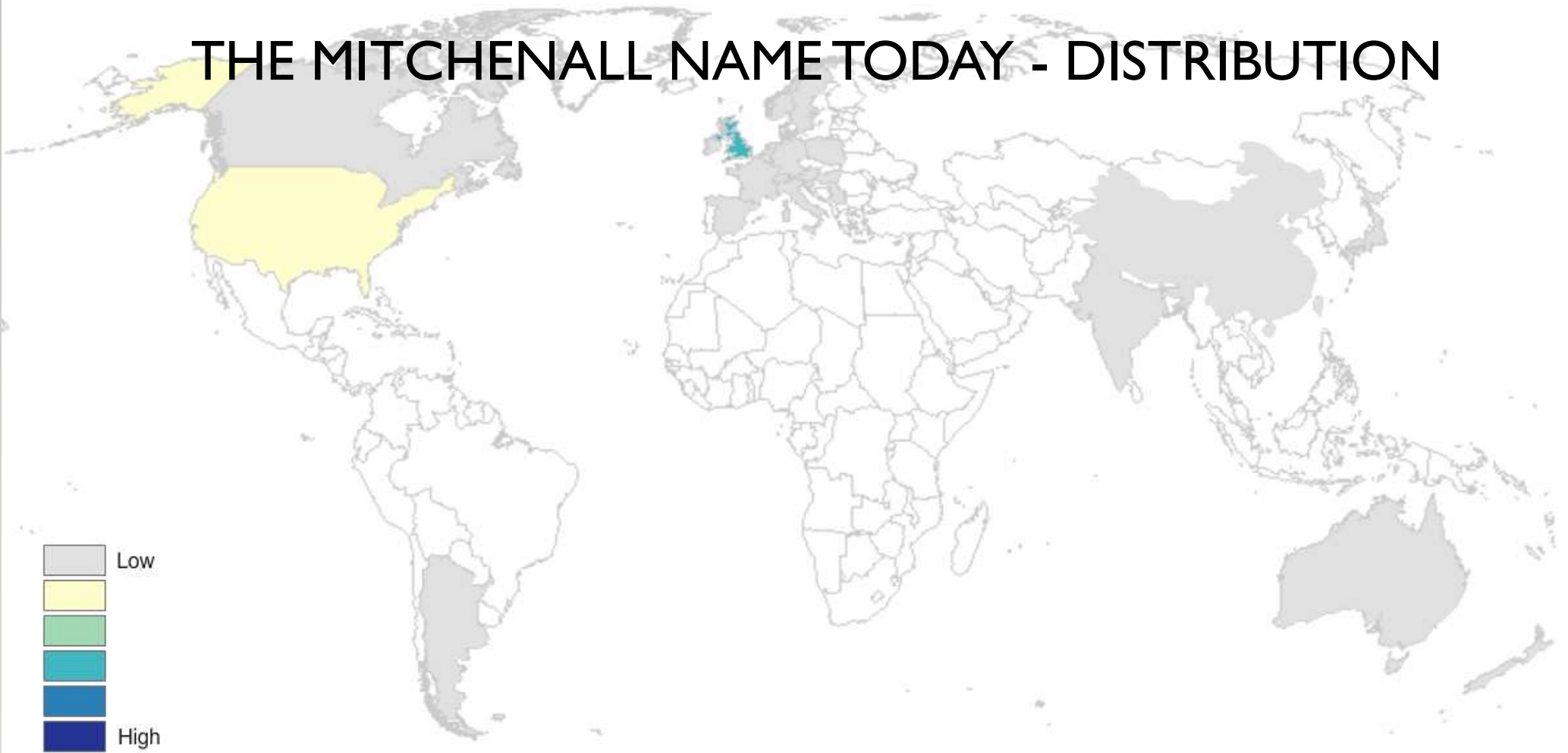


William with Family about 1880

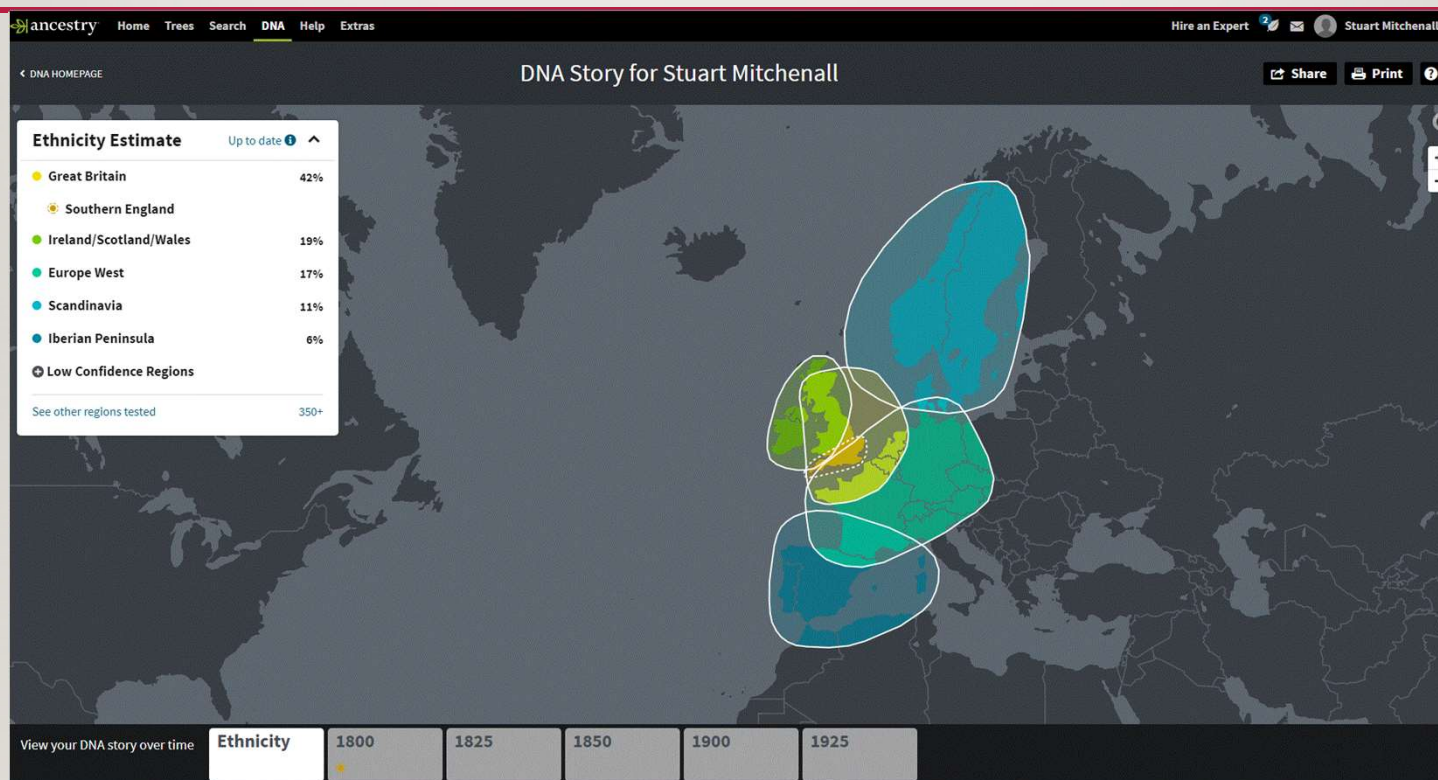

INTERESTING MITCHENALLS?

- Harold – One of the last descendants of John Mitchenall
 - Seems to have chased his wife to be, a married woman, to Switzerland and then the USA
 - Both worked for Nescafe, as did her husband, and both lived near each other in London and Switzerland
- George – One of the three sons of William with Mitchenall descendants
 - The only Mitchenall I have found with a criminal record – although not exactly of international importance
 - Two marriages, 14 children, and father to lines of living Mitchenalls in the US, Salisbury and Worcester
 - His son Simon married at Christ Church, Gypsy Hill, in 1888 where Cath and Stuart Mitchenall now attend church
 - Owain and Henry, Stuarts younger grandsons, attend the school which was Salters Hill School, attended by Georges sons
- There aren't, however, any ancestors more famous than the current Generations – will there be in future?
